The Bulloch County Board of Commissioners met on the above date in the Commissioner's Office. All members were present. Chairman Emit Deal gave the invocation.

The minutes of the October meeting were approved as read.

A delegation requesting the paving of the Burkhalter road met with the Board.


The Bulloch County Drug Abuse Council met with the Board to request a building site for a new building on the Airport property. Mr. Deal is to check with Ed Cone about existing water lines and a proposed Industrial Park on a portion of the area before giving clearance to the Drug Abuse Council for surveying.

Mr. Lawrence Ray announced that the Coffee Construction Company was the low bidder for a culvert on the Cypress Lake-Country Club Road at \$29,000.00. Upon motion of Wilson Groover, seconded by John Paul Ellis, the bid was accepted.

Mr. W. E. Brinson requested a 30" culvert to be placed on Land Locked Property in the County. The Board agreed to put in the culvert provided the road is deeded to the County and built according to specifications provided by the County.

Upon a request by Carl Sammons, the Board agreed to raise the feeding of prisoners from \$3.30 to \$3.50 per day at the County Jail.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned, subject to call.

The Bulloch County Board of Commissioners met on the above date in the Commissioner's Office. All members were present. Mr. Wilson Groover gave the invocation.

Three Beer & Wine Licenses were approved:

The Moses Toole application was not approved due to the three year residency clause.

Mrs. Marion Seegers and a delegation from the Collins Lake Area came before the group asking about rabies inoculation enforcement of dogs. The Board will check with the County Attorney as to a County Ordinance.

The Board appointed John Rushing and Lehman Dekle to the Bulloch County Industrial Development Authority for a 5 year term.

Possible Local legislation was discussed to prohibit hunting on Sunday in Bulloch County. The Board decided to check with the County Attorney and the local legislators to set up a bill.

The Budget for the two Superior Court Judges was discussed. The matter was tabled for further investigation.

The Public Defender Budget was discussed and approved for 1979. Mr. Wilson Groover made the motion, seconded by Mr. Ellis, to approve the \$25,340.00 budget.

No decision was made on the Community Development Block Grant Application for the new year.

Three names were nominated for the Bulloch Hospital Authority to fill the unexpired term of Weldon Dupree as follows:

Hub Powell with the Probation Office came before the Board and requested the County's payment of their phone bill every month. The matter was tabled for further consideration.

On the question of payment for a culvert on the Cecil Anderson and W. E. Brunson property, it was decided that since this was a private road that the County would have to be reimbursed.

A resolution was adopted and signed for Bulloch County to receive a grant-in-aid-award through the Department of Natural Resources for a Solid Waste Truck. Said Resolution authorizes Chairman Deal to sign and accept the grant.

Three acres of land was approved for the Bulloch Drug Abuse Council for a building site to be used as long as it is used solely by them. When it ceases to be used for above purpose it will automatically revert back to the Bulloch County-Statesboro Airport.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned, subject to call.
