Public Hearing

The Board of Commissioners met at 6:30 p.m. in the Community Room of the North Main Annex. Chairman Nevil welcomed guests and called the meeting to order.

The following commissioners were present: Chairman Nevil, Commissioner Tankersley, Commissioner Simmons, Commissioner Jackson, Commissioner Rushing, and Commissioner Thompson. The following staff were present: County Manager Thomas Couch, Staff Attorney Jeff Akins, County Attorney Charles Brown, Clerk of the Board Maggie Fitzgerald, Chief Financial Officer Harry Starling, and Planning and Zoning Development Director Andy Welch.

The only item of business was the duly advertised Public Hearing for the proposed Fiscal Year 2010 General Appropriations Budget. The Public Notice, as advertised in the County's Legal Organ, is shown as Exhibit # 2009-64. Commissioner Tankersley offered a motion to open the Public Hearing. Commissioner Simmons seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously. Chairman Nevil yielded the floor to County Manager Thomas Couch.

Mr. Couch stated that the major assumptions and objectives were discussed at the Budget Hearing this morning. With only one citizen in attendance, Mr. Couch asked if there were any questions regarding the Fiscal Year 2010 General Appropriations Budget. Hearing none, Mr. Couch yielded the floor to the Chairman.

Without further discussion, Commissioner Simmons offered a motion to close the Public Hearing. Commissioner Jackson seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.
