MATERIAL	WHAT TO RECYCLE	HOW TO RECYCLE	WHAT NOT TO DO
MIXED PAPER & MAGAZINES	Clean dry envelopes, mail, folders, posters, office paper, magazines	All paper should be dry & clean, newsprint is OK if separate bin is not provided	No brown paper, tissue, or trash
NEWSPRINT	At Centers where provided, all news-grade paper	Neatly stack newspapers in walk-in container labeled "newsprint only"	No mixed paper or grades other than newsprint, newsprint in paper bags is OK
CARDBOARD	Clean, dry corrugated cardboard	Neatly stack cardboard in walk-in container labeled "cardboard only"	No food product boxes, detergent boxes, wax coated boxes, or plastic lined boxes
PET PLASTIC (#1)	Plastic containers labeled with "1" in the recycle symbol	Clean bottles only, Remove tops, labels OK, clean bottles only	No plastics 2 -7, no film plastic
HDPE PLASTIC (#2)	Plastic containers labeled with "2" in the recycle symbol	Separate frosted containers & colored containers into adjacent bins	No plastics 1 or 3-7, no film plastic
GLASS	Brown, clear, and green glass containers, separated	Place each type of glass in container labeled with appropriate color	No pyrex, ceramics, or blue glass
METAL CANS	Aluminum and Steel cans	Place aluminum and steel cans in bin together, clean cans only	No aluminum foil or containers larger than 1 gallon
YARDWASTE	Grass clippings, brush, leaves, limbs	Place in yard waste bin	No stumps, logs or rocks
SCRAP METAL	Appliances and other scrap metal accepted		
CLOTHING	Items normally given to Goodwill	Place INSIDE Goodwill containers	Large items should be taken to the Goodwill or Habitat ReStore
TIRES	From passenger vehicles	Remove all metal rims, wheels. Limit 4 per person per day.	No tractor or large truck tires. From Individuals only.
USED OIL	Oil from cars and other vehicles, transmission fluid, hydraulic fluid and used oil filters.	See attendant for assistance	No gasoline solvents or antifreeze. No diesel fuel.
