In this election.....

- ❖ You do not have to declare a party.
- ❖ All candidates (Republican, Democrat, and Libertarian) for an office are on one ballot.
- ❖ You can “mix” your parties. For example: In one office you can vote a Republican and in another office you can vote Democrat.
- ❖ There are no Nonpartisan Offices. The election for the Judges and the Board of Education were held in the May General Primary – Nonpartisan General Election.

BRING YOUR PHOTO ID WHEN VOTING



ID is required when voting.....

- A GEORGIA DRIVER'S LICENSE; or
- Valid identification card “picture” issued by a branch, department, agency or entity of the State of Georgia, another state; or
- Valid United States passport; or
- Valid employee identification card containing a photograph of and issued by any branch, department, agency or entity of the United States government, this state, or any county, municipality board, authority, or
- Other entity of this state; or valid US military identification card with photograph; or
- Valid tribal identification card with photograph

NO CAMPAIGNING
BY ANYONE (INCLUDING CANDIDATES) WITHIN 150 FEET OF THE OUTER EDGE OF ANY BUILDING WITHIN WHICH A POLLING PLACE IS ESTABLISHED. (OCGA 21-2-413 AND 21-2-414)

This includes caps/hats, campaign buttons/stickers, t-shirts/shirts, signs of all types, bumper stickers and conversations; no one is exempt from this.

This applies to early voting locations during early voting and Election Day Precincts.
