## Ordinance Standards

- The activity, operation or noise source will be of a temporary duration, and cannot be conducted in compliance with the provisions of this article and no reasonable alternative is available.
- The applicant requires additional time to alter or modify the activity to comply with the provisions of this article, and no reasonable alternative is available.
- The activity is being conducted for a public purpose by, or at the direction of, a governmental entity.

## Ordinance Violations

- Radios, phonographs and similar devices.* The operation of any set, instrument, phonograph, recorder, compact disc player, or other machine or device any day between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. in a manner as to be plainly audible at a distance of 100 feet or more from the building, structure, vehicle, chamber, or immediate vicinity in which it is located shall be prima facie evidence of a violation of this section.
- Yelling, shouting, hooting, whistling, or singing.* Yelling, shouting, hooting, whistling, or singing on the public streets, particularly any day between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. or at any time or place so as to annoy or disturb the quiet, comfort or repose of a reasonable person in any office, dwelling, hotel, or other type of residence or of any reasonable person in the vicinity.
- Schools, courts, places of worship and hospitals.* The creation of any excessive noise on any street adjacent to any school, institution of learning, place of worship, or court, while in use, or adjacent to any hospital which unreasonably interferes with the normal operation of that institution, or which disturbs or unduly annoys patients in the hospital.
- Hawkers, peddlers and vendors.* The shouting and crying of peddlers, hawkers, and vendors which disturb the peace and quiet of any reasonable person in the neighborhood.
- Noises to attract attention.* The use of any drum or other instrument or device for the purpose of attracting attention to any performance, show or sale by creation of noise.
- Loudspeakers and amplifiers.* The use of mechanical loudspeakers or amplifiers when used at such an unreasonably loud volume so as to unreasonably disturb a reasonable person in his or her residence, offices, schools, hospitals, churches, or courts. The use of mechanical loudspeakers or amplifiers between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. in a manner as to be plainly audible at a distance of 100 feet or more shall be prima facie evidence of a violation of this section.
