## VOTER INFORMATION

- ❖ A voter must decide which ballot style to vote – Democrat, Republican, or Nonpartisan in the **May General Primary**.
  - NOTE: How you vote in May will determine how you vote in the July Primary Runoff Election.
    - If you vote Republican in May, you will have to vote Republican in July
    - If you vote Democratic in May, you will have to vote Democratic in July
    - If you vote Nonpartisan in May, you can choose to vote Democratic or Republican in July.
    - If you did not vote in May, you can vote in July. You will have to decide which primary to vote in – Democratic or Republican
- ❖ In the **November General Election**, you will not be asked to select a party. All candidates for that office will appear on the same ballot.

## ELECTION DATES



### May 24, 2022 General Primary (Democrat & Republican)

#### General Nonpartisan Election

- Begin Accepting Absentee Ballot Applications – March 7<sup>th</sup>
- Begin Mailing Out Absentee Ballots – April 25<sup>th</sup> to May 13<sup>th</sup>
- (UOCAVA will be mailed earlier)
- Last Day to Register or Change Name/Address – April 25<sup>th</sup>
- Advance Voting starts May 2<sup>nd</sup> – May 20<sup>th</sup>
- Saturday voting May 7<sup>th</sup> -May 14<sup>th</sup>

### June 21, 2022

#### General Primary Runoff Local/State/Federal Races



- Begin Accepting Absentee Ballot Applications – April 5<sup>th</sup> (UOCAVA ballots will be mailed earlier)
- Begin Mailing Out Absentee Ballots – June 10<sup>th</sup>
- Last Day to Register or Change Name/Address – April 25
- **If federal candidates** are on the runoff ballot, the last day to register to vote is May 23<sup>rd</sup>
- Advance Voting starts no later than June 13<sup>th</sup>
- Saturday Voting TBD

### November 8 2022 General Election (Democrat & Republican)



- Begin Accepting Absentee Ballot Applications – Aug 22<sup>nd</sup>
- Begin Mailing Out Absentee Ballots – Oct 10<sup>th</sup>
- Last Day to Register or Change Name/Address – Oct 11<sup>th</sup>
- Advance Voting starts – Oct 17<sup>th</sup> – Nov 4<sup>th</sup>
- Saturday voting Oct 22<sup>nd</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup>



### December 6, 2022 General Election Runoff Local/State Races (if needed)

- Begin Accepting Absentee Ballot Applications – Sept 20<sup>th</sup>
- Begin Mailing Out Absentee Ballots – as soon as ballots received.
- Last Day to Register or Change Name/Address – October 11<sup>th</sup>
- **If federal candidates** are on the runoff ballot, the last day to register to vote is Oct 11<sup>th</sup>
- Advance Voting starts Nov 28<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>

## QUALIFYING DATES

### ❖ Democratic, Republican, & Nonpartisan Candidates

Monday, March 7<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m.  
to  
Friday, March 11<sup>th</sup> at noon

### ❖ Independent Candidates

Monday, March 7<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m.  
to  
Friday, March 11<sup>th</sup> at noon

*In addition to qualifying in March, an Independent Candidate must also file their nomination petition as part of their qualifying during the week of June 27<sup>th</sup> (9 a.m.) to July 12<sup>th</sup> (noon).*

### ❖ Write-In Candidates

A write-in candidate shall give notice of intent of candidacy by filing notice with our office and publish it. This can be done at any time between January 1<sup>st</sup> and September 6<sup>th</sup>.

No later than September 6<sup>th</sup>, a write-in candidate shall file a copy of the notice as published along with an affidavit with our office.

### NONPARTISAN WRITE-IN CANDIDATE

Should have published their intent and filed their affidavit with our office no later than March 18<sup>th</sup>

HOW CAN I



- 1) **EARLY/ADVANCE VOTING** is in person, no excuse voting prior to the Election Day.
- 2) **MAIL-OUT ABSENTEE BALLOT** – A voter can complete an Application for an Absentee Ballot. Once we receive your application, we can mail your ballot to the address requested if outside of Bulloch County or to the address where you are currently registered to vote in the county (or alternate address for physically disabled voter).
- 3) **ELECTION DAY VOTING** is at your voting precinct from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
