

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Bulloch County Board of Commissioners has tentatively adopted a millage rate, which will require an increase in property taxes by 7.06 percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to a public hearing on this tax increase to be held at the Bulloch County North Main Annex, 115 North Main Street, Statesboro, on August 9, 2022 at 6:00 PM.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase will be held at the Bulloch County North Main Annex, 115 North Main Street, Statesboro, on August 16, 2022 at 8:30 AM; and August 16, 2022 at 6:00 PM.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 11.350, an increase of 0.748 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 10.602 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$175,000 is approximately \$51.76, and the proposed tax increase for a non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$175,000 is approximately \$52.36. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$200,000 is approximately \$59.24, and the proposed tax increase for a non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$200,000 is approximately \$59.84.
