L & A TESTING, COMPUTATION & CANVASSING AND ABSENTEE VOTING

DECEMBER 6, 2022, GENERAL ELECTION FEDERAL RUNOFF

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. & 21.2-379.6 (c) notice is hereby given that the logic and accuracy testing on the voting equipment to be used in the December 6th, 2022, General Election Federal Runoff for Bulloch County will be performed by the election supervisor and staff members of the Board of Elections and Registrations Office. Testing on all equipment will begin as early as November 18th, 2022, at 9:00AM (or once database has been received from the SOS Office). Testing will continue from day to day from 9AM-12PM and from 1PM to 4PM until completed. Said testing and preparation will be conducted partially in the basement on the BMDs (ballot marking devices) at the North Main Annex at 115 North Main Street, Statesboro Ga 30458 and on the Tabulator/Scanners at the Hagin Precinct located at 5023 Clito Road, Statesboro, GA 30461 due to the construction at the North Main Annex Building. Pursuant to O.C.G.A § 21.2.492 Computation, canvassing and certification of election results will begin on Tuesday, December 6, 2022, at the Bulloch County Annex, located at 113 North Main Street, Ste. 201, Statesboro Ga 30458 until complete.

The last day to register to vote for the upcoming December 6th, 2022, General Election Federal Runoff was Monday, November 7, 2022. The absentee ballot by mail process will begin as soon as possible or when ballots are received through Friday, November 25th, 2022. Advance Voting (in-person) will commence Monday, November 28, 2022, and run through Friday, December 2, 2022, from 8:00am-5:00pm at the Bulloch County Board of Elections and Registration Office located at 113 North Main Street, Ste 201, Statesboro, Georgia 30458. There will be NO Saturday Voting for this election.
