Write-In Candidates

Candidates shall give their notice of intent of candidacy by filing it with our office and publishing it. This can be done at any time between

January 1st and:

- ✤ March 15th (for the Nonpartisan Election)
- September 3rd (for the General Election)

No later than **September 3rd**, a write-in candidate shall file a copy of the notice as published along with an affidavit with our office.

NONPARTISAN WRITE-IN

CANDIDATES should publish their intent and file their affidavit with our office no later than March 15th.

Persons interested in running for office are encouraged to speak with the Election Supervisor for additional information.

How Can I Vote?

1) **EARLY/ADVANCE VOTING** is

in-person, no-excuse voting prior to the Election Day.

2) MAIL-OUT ABSENTEE

BALLOT – A voter can complete an Application for an Absentee Ballot. Once we receive your application, we can mail your ballot to the address requested, outside of Bulloch County or to the address where you are <u>currently registered to vote</u> within the county (or alternate address for physically disabled voter).

ELECTION DAY VOTING is at your voting precinct from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
