Presidential Preference Primary:

*You may choose either a*

**Democratic Ballot**

*or*

**Republican Ballot**

*This decision WILL NOT affect future elections.*

❖ For the May General Primary:

*You may choose either a*

**Democratic Ballot**

*or*

**Republican Ballot**

*and may only vote in your chosen party's primary in the event of a run-off.*

*This decision WILL NOT affect future elections.*

**Nonpartisan Races** in the **Nonpartisan Election** will appear on **BOTH** ballots.

In the **November General Election**, you will **not** be asked to select a party. All candidates for that office will appear on the **same ballot**

## ELECTION DATES

March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024

### **Presidential Preference Primary**

- December 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023 - March 1<sup>st</sup> - Absentee Ballot Application window
- February 12<sup>th</sup> - Begin mailing out Absentee Ballots (UOCAVA will be mailed earlier)
- February 12<sup>th</sup> - Last day to register or change name/address
- February 19<sup>th</sup> - March 8<sup>th</sup> - Advance Voting
- February 24<sup>th</sup> & March 2<sup>nd</sup> - Saturday Voting

May 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024

### **General Primary Nonpartisan Election**

- March 4<sup>th</sup> - May 10<sup>th</sup> - Absentee Ballot Application window
- April 22<sup>nd</sup> - Begin mailing out Absentee Ballots (UOCAVA will be mailed earlier)
- April 22<sup>nd</sup> - Last day to register or change name/address
- April 29<sup>th</sup> - May 17<sup>th</sup> - Advance Voting
- May 4<sup>th</sup> & May 11<sup>th</sup> - Saturday Voting

June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2024

### **General Primary Runoff General Runoff for Federal Offices**

- April 1<sup>st</sup> - June 7<sup>th</sup> - Absentee Ballot Application window
- Absentee Ballots will be mailed **ASAP**
- May 20<sup>th</sup> - Last day to register or change name/address in the event of a Federal-Office Runoff
- Advance Voting may begin no later than June 6<sup>th</sup> - June 14<sup>th</sup>
- Saturday Voting **TBD**

November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024

## **General Election**

- August 19<sup>th</sup> - October 25<sup>th</sup> - Absentee Ballot Application window
- October 7<sup>th</sup> - Begin mailing out Absentee Ballots (UOCAVA will be mailed earlier)
- October 7<sup>th</sup> - Last day to register or change name/address
- October 15<sup>th</sup> - November 1<sup>st</sup> - Advance Voting
- October 19<sup>th</sup> & October 26<sup>th</sup> - Saturday Voting

December 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024

### **General Runoff General Runoff for Federal Offices**

- August 16<sup>th</sup> - November 22<sup>nd</sup> - Absentee Ballot Application window
- Absentee Ballots will be mailed **ASAP**
- November 4<sup>th</sup> - Last day to register or change name/address in the event of a Federal-Office Runoff
- Advance Voting may begin no later than November 25<sup>th</sup> - November 27<sup>th</sup>
- Saturday Voting **TBD**

## QUALIFYING DATES

### ❖ **Democrat, Republican, and Independent Candidates**

from

**Monday, March 4<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m.**

through

**Friday, March 8<sup>th</sup> at Noon**

*(Independents require a nomination petition to be filed as part of their qualification between June 24<sup>th</sup> & July 9<sup>th</sup>)*

### ❖ **Write-In Candidates**

Candidates shall give their notice of intent of candidacy by filing it with our office and publishing it. This can be done at any time between

**January 1<sup>st</sup>** and:

❖ **March 15<sup>th</sup>** (for the Nonpartisan Election)

❖ **September 3<sup>rd</sup>** (for the General Election)

No later than **September 3<sup>rd</sup>**, a write-in candidate shall file a copy of the notice as published along with an affidavit with our office.

### NONPARTISAN WRITE-IN CANDIDATES

should publish their intent and file their affidavit with our office no later than March 15<sup>th</sup>.

## HOW CAN I VOTE?

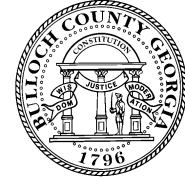
- 1) **EARLY/ADVANCE VOTING** is in-person, no-excuse voting prior to the Election Day.
- 2) **MAIL-OUT ABSENTEE BALLOT** – A voter can complete an Application for an Absentee Ballot. Once we receive your application, we can mail your ballot to the address requested, outside of Bulloch County or to the address where you are currently registered to vote *within* the county (or alternate address for physically disabled voter).
- 3) **ELECTION DAY VOTING** is at your voting precinct from **7:00 a.m.** to **7:00 p.m.**
