Ways to Vote

1. EARLY/ADVANCE VOTING (IN-PERSON, NO EXCUSE)

BULLOCH COUNTY ANNEX ELECTION OFFICE OCTOBER 15th - NOVEMBER 1st | MON-FRI FROM 8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M. 113 North Main Street, Suite 201, Statesboro, GA 30458 Will include TWO SATURDAYS - OCT 19th and OCT 26th

During the early/advance voting timeframe, there will be two satellite sites available:

Georgia Southern University (GSU) - 85 Georgia Ave. October 22 - 24 from 8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.

Downtown Statesboro Development Authority – 64 East Main Street October 28 - November 1 from 8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.

2. MAIL-OUT ABSENTEE BALLOT

from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

Voters can complete an Application for an Absentee Ballot. Once we receive it, we can mail your ballot to the address requested, outside of Bulloch County or to the address where you are currently registered to vote within the county (or alternate address for physically disabled voter). The deadline to request an Absentee Ballot is OCTOBER 25th.

3. ELECTION DAY

This will occur at your voting precinct on NOVEMBER 5th from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM.

BRING YOUR PHOTO I.D.

- A Georgia Driver's License; or
- Valid identification card "picture" issued by a branch, department, agency or entity of the State of Georgia, another
- Valid United States passport; or
- Valid employee identification card containing a photograph of and issued by any branch, department, agency or entity of the United States government, this state, or any country municipality board, authority, or
- · Other entity of this state; or valid US military identification card with photograph; or
- · Valid tribal identification card with photograph

Bulloch County has:

- 3 House of Representative Districts up for election (158, 159, 160)
 - 2 County Commission Districts. District 1 has 2 representatives, and this year, Seat 1A is up for election. District 2 has 4 representatives – this year Seats 2A & 2C are up for election. The county commissioners have staggered terms.

When you vote, you may not see an office on your ballot. Why? The office may not have a candidate qualify in the party you are voting or you may be in the district that is not up for election.
