INFORMATION FOR THE JUNE 16, 2026, RUNOFF

1. In the event of a **FEDERAL-OFFICE RUNOFF**, the registration deadline is **MAY 18th**.
2. **ABSENTEE BALLOT BY MAIL:** The deadline to request an absentee ballot for the Runoff is **JUNE 5th**.
3. **EARLY VOTING:** Early Voting for the Runoff Election is **Monday, June 8th, through Friday, June 12th, from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm**. Voting will be held at the Bulloch County Annex **ONLY !!!!**

EARLY VOTING AT THE BULLOCH COUNTY ANNEX ENDS ON FRIDAY, MAY 15TH, AT 5:00 PM!!!

Tuesday, MAY 19TH, is ELECTION DAY. You must go to your county precinct to cast your vote!
