Cancelled Scenario AIP: If a voter comes to vote in person and then decides not to vote after a voter card is programmed, that voter's ballot can be canceled. This would allow the voter to cast their ballot at another time.

Cancelled Scenario ABM: voter requests an absentee ballot by mail, then chooses to cancel the mailed ballot and wants to vote in person, voter changes the party ballot they originally requested.

Rejected Scenario ABM: Voter applies for an absentee ballot by mail but is not registered to vote in Bulloch County, submits the absentee application too early or too late, is not registered at the address on the voter record within the county, and is not physically disabled. voter ballot is received after the deadline (*after 7:00 pm on the day of the ELECTION*).

Spoiled Scenario AMB: voter makes an error on the ballot they received and requests a new ballot be re-issued.

Cancelled Scenario EBD: Voter chooses a different party ballot than originally requested, voter returns home and chooses to vote in-person.

Rejected Scenario EBD: UOCAVA Voter applies for an electronic ballot, but the voter is not registered to vote in Bulloch County; the voter submitted an absentee application too early or too late; or the voter's ballot is received after the deadline (*UOCAVA ballots can be accepted through 5:00pm on the Friday preceding the election if postmarked by the current election date*).
